Ian Gardner will lead a spring raptor migration field trip to Tussey Mountain, with a focus on Golden Eagles.

This location records about 200 goldens during spring migration from mid-February to mid-April. There are other birds of interest migrating as well, including finches, waterfowl and other raptors.

Meet at 9:30am at Jo Hays Vista along Route 26 south of State College. The drive is about 2 hours from Harrisburg.

Bring binoculars, lunch, and water. Dress in warm layers, as the weather varies in spring.

Restrooms are located nearby, but not on site.
