**Appalachian Audubon has changed the format of the Birdseed Sale for 2017, to make it easier and more convenient for customers and volunteers.**

During the month of November, take your completed order form to either of our partner Agway stores:

- **East Shore:** Hanoverdale Country Store, Inc. in West Hanover Township at 486 S. Hershey Rd., Route 39 Harrisburg, PA 17112. *Hours:* Monday through Saturday 8:00 am – 6:00 pm; Sunday 10:00 am – 4:00 pm.
- **West Shore:** Davis Country Living at 45 W. Allen St, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055. *Hours:* Monday through Friday 8:00 am – 5:30 pm; Saturday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm; closed Sunday.
- Pay at the Agway store of your choice for your order, using cash, check, or credit card.
- While picking up your bird seed at the Agway store of your choice, choose from a wide variety of feeders and other bird-related gear available at the store.
- Your birdseed will be loaded into your car for you.
- Remember, you don't need to mail an order form or a check to Audubon. Turning in the completed order form at one of the partner stores will ensure that AAS benefits from your purchase.

# Seed Description

*(List matches order form)*

**BLACK OIL SUNFLOWER SEED** — Oil sunflower seeds have more meat per pound and the oil provides needed calories and high energy.

**FAVORITE WILD BIRD FEED** — A mixture of some striped sunflower, cracked corn, millet, wheat, and milo.

**BIRDSNACK WILD BIRD FEED** — Triple the sunflower in "Favorite" blended with canary seed, cracked corn, hulled oats, wheat, white millet and peanut hearts.

**FLYERS' CHOICE** — A premium selection of high energy ingredients. At least 50% oil and striped sunflower and sunflower kernels, plus millet and safflower.

**CARDINAL'S CHOICE** — Oil sunflower, sunflower kernels, and safflower.

**CHICKADEE'S CHOICE** — Sunflower kernels, tree nut pieces, peanuts, oil sunflower, striped sunflower, and safflower.

**WOODPECKER'S PICK** — Tree nut pieces, peanuts, corn, sunflower kernels, dried fruit, and pepitas.

**HIGH ENERGY FRUIT & NUT** — Premium blend of sunflower, fruits, nuts and safflower.

**SUNFLOWER MEATIES** — Oil sunflower seeds blended with hulled sunflower seeds and pieces — great energy food.

**SUNFLOWER HEARTS** — Sunflower seeds without the shells.

**SUNFLOWER KERNELS** — Full kernels, no shells.

**PEANUT HEARTS** — Finely chopped peanuts

**ROASTED SHELLED PEANUTS** — Whole and half peanuts out of their shell.

**NYJER (THISTLE) SEED** — High in oil content, for use in nyjer/thistle feeders.

**FINCH DELIGHT** — Small sunflower hearts, canary and nyjer seeds.

**SAFFLOWER SEED** — Looks like a sunflower seed with a white hull.

**CRACKED CORN** — Coarse-sized bits of corn

**SHELL-LESS SELECT** — Premium blend with no shells for less waste. Millet, sunflower seeds, peanuts, tree nut pieces, and pepitas.

**SUET CAKES** — Made from beef fat or peanut butter, mixed with seeds or insects, formed into shapes.

## Birds Attracted

Chickadees, sparrows, cardinals, jays, nuthatches, goldfinches, house finches.

Good mix for ground feeders, including doves, sparrows, juncos, towhees.

Doves, sparrows, finches, cardinals, woodpeckers, jays.

Attracts colorful birds, including blue jays, chickadees, cardinals, finches.

A basic mix for a wide variety of birds.

Chickadees, all the feeder favorites, plus woodpeckers.

Works well in tubular wire-mesh woodpecker feeders, or any feeder.

Fruit attracts mockingbirds, cardinals, jays, tanagers, bluebirds. Nuts bring in titmice, nuthatches, chickadees.

Attractive to a wide variety of birds.

Attractive to many birds, with the benefit of no shells and less mess.

A favorite of woodpeckers, jays, chickadees, titmice, and nuthatches.

Relished by woodpeckers, nuthatches, chickadees and more.

Primarily for goldfinches and house finches.

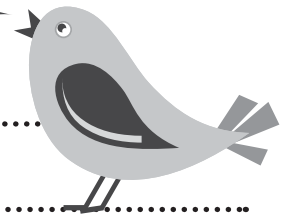
A different blend for nyjer feeders; sometimes preferred over nyjer.

Cardinals, doves, finches, jays, nuthatches. Discourages some squirrels.

For ground-feeding birds, such as doves, sparrows, juncos, towhees.

A favorite of jays, orioles, nuthatches, chickadees, and mockingbirds.

Jays, titmice, woodpeckers, goldfinches, mockingbirds.

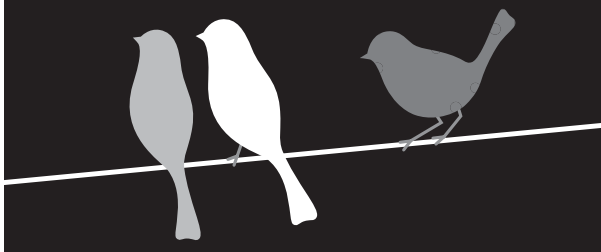
