Scholarships cover the entire camp fee of \$1,695. The applicant must arrange and pay for their own transportation to and from the Audubon dock in Bremen, Maine at the start & end of the session. If the participant cancels their registration once selected as a scholarship awardee, they may need to refund the full or a portion of the scholarship funds to Appalachian Audubon Society.

First consideration will be given to applicants living in the membership region; others in southcentral PA may qualify. You do not need to be an AAS member to apply.
